On Eagles' Wings Capital Campaign

Computer Hardware / Software for Media Center (\$15,000). Our existing media center has 18 computers and we are looking to upgrade to newer machines to allow for excellent exposure to technology for our students.

Debt Reduction (\$760,000). Martin Luther's current mortgage debt is approximately \$760,000. Martin Luther has approximately \$150,000 in funds available to cover the principal and interest on this debt; the mortgage payments will need to be serviced from tuition dollars after these funds are depleted (approximately June 2015). Therefore, it is important for Martin Luther to reduce or eliminate this debt before June 2015.

HVAC Upgrades (\$5,000). Martin Luther's building has at least one, and maybe two, HVAC units that were not "new" when the building was purchased and renovated for the school. It is expected that this unit(s) will need to be replaced within the next 12 months.

Parking Lot Repair/Expansion (\$120,000). Martin Luther's parking lot needs to be repaired and expanded. The existing parking lot is deteriorating and must be resurfaced soon. This work will involve stripping and replacing the existing surface, repairing underlayment and re-stripping. Additional parking in the vacant area to the west of the school's main entrance is sorely needed.

Gym Bleachers (\$32,500). Constructing / installing bleacher seating in the Gymnasium will facilitate greater seating capacity and better viewing for audiences at games, concerts, plays and other events.

72nd Street Monument Sign (\$7,500). Signage about Martin Luther is needed on 72nd Street. Installing signs on the Gymnasium's north wall is restricted by KCMO codes. A monument sign has been approved.

Kitchen Remodeling w/Dishwasher (\$60,000). The need for food preparation capabilities will grow as Martin Luther's enrollment grows. Lunches presently are catered each day. This project would involve remodeling and reconfiguring the space, acquiring kitchen equipment/appliances and complying with health codes. Presently, lunches are served using paper plates and plastic silverware (plastic cups are washed by hand by volunteers daily). Installing a commercial dishwasher in the kitchen will allow the use of "permanent" plates and silverware, thus eliminating this expense from the school's operating budget (and providing a more "green" environment!).

Entrance Canopies/Airlock Doors (\$35,000). Martin Luther's current "drop off/pick up" zone is uncovered, presenting issues during inclement weather. A covered walkway would resolve these issues. Martin Luther's main entrance currently has no air lock, creating issues with keeping the foyer of the building warm in the winter and cool in the summer. Adding a typical double entry will increase the energy efficiency and security of the building.

Office/Study/Bath/Team Rooms (\$25,000). Unused space between the foyer and the east door to the playground would be enclosed to provide small tutoring rooms. The basement (under the Gymnasium) is plumbed for a bathroom. We plan to install a bathroom there, together with additional tutoring rooms and a couple of small breakout rooms that could be used by athletic teams.
